? If you are between the ages of 15 and 19, your school must complete an enrollment form when you get your license. If you already have yours, you may recall getting someone at the school to sign it for you. If you drop out of school or have serious attendance issues, that same form is sent to the Department of Public Safety and your driver's license will be

If your license is suspended, you can't drive and you will not be able to get your license reinstated until you are again in compliance (enrolled and attending school regularly or until you have obtained a GED). You will have also have to pay a significant fee to the state of Alabama to get your license again.

? First, it is the law in the state under §16-28-40 through §16-28-45, Code of Alabama, 1975. More importantly, you need to be in school and you need to get your diploma. Right now, you are not only learning academics, you are learning to be responsible and showing up on time every day is part of that. The more ta
